Shohby Traders** as a bidder with Least Evaluated Cost i.e Rs,2,665,100/- meeting all the specifications mentioned in the bidding document. As the team visited the Shoby's showroom and inspected quality, the quality is comparatively better. He has additional advantage of working with the Govt. of Sindh several times. The Committee, therefore, recommend to award the contract to Shoby, as the diff is below 3%.
